PROFILE OF

DR. MICHAEL CLOUGH

Research Associate, University of California-Berkeley

Dr. Michael Clough is a Research Associate at the Institute of International Studies at the University of California-Berkeley, where he is in charge of developing the Berkeley Global Policy Forum.

In the early 1990s, he served as a senior policy advisor on Africa for the presidential campaign of Bill Clinton and Al Gore. Over the past year (1999-2000), he has served as a member of the foreign policy issues staff for the presidential campaign of Bill Bradley.

Dr. Clough received an M.A. and Ph.D. (on US policy on Africa) in Political Science from the University of California-Berkeley and a Ph.D. from the University of California-Santa Barbara. From 1980 to 1987 he taught in the Department of National Security Affairs at the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, California. In addition, he as taught courses in foreign policy and international relations at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, Columbia University and the University of California-Berkeley.

- Between 1991 and 1992, Dr. Clough was the principal advisor on Africa for the Bill Clinton-Al Gore Presidential campaign. And in 1994 he was a Co-Chair of the White House Conference on Africa.
- Between 1992 and 1994, Dr. Clough served as the senior writer for the International Commission on Global Governance
- Between 1986 and 1987, he served as the Study Director for the Secretary of State's Advisory Committee on South Africa.

1987-1996: Before returning to Berkeley in 1996, Dr. Clough was a Senior Fellow at the Council on Foreign Relations. During his tenure at the Council, he directed the African Studies program and created a new program on the changing domestic base of American foreign policy.

1992-1997: Dr. Clough conceived and Co-Chaired the Stanley Foundation's New American Global Policy Forum which brought together leaders from government, academia, business and the independent sector for a series of regional conferences on the changing nature of America's relationships with the world.

He has also been a Research Fellow at the Brookings Institution, an Adjunct Senior Fellow at the Center for Strategic and International Studies, and on the Human Rights Watch Advisory Committee on Africa.

Dr. Clough has published more than a hundred articles and books on a diverse range of subjects including U.S. policy toward Africa, U.S. Foreign Policy and Globalization. He is a regular contributor to the Sunday Opinion section of the *Los Angeles Times*. In addition, his articles have appeared in *Foreign Affairs*, *Foreign Policy*, *The Nation*, *Current History*, the *New York Times* Sunday Book Review, the *Washington Post* and *Africa Report*. He has also worked as a consultant to *CBS News*.
