

**Timelines for the XIV International Congress of Slavists
Ochrid, Macedonia, September 2008**

May 1, 2006: Submission of Proposals for Panels (*bloky*)

Rules: Submission is made by a person designated as the “Organizer” of the panel. Each panel must contain 3-4 papers by participants from at least 3 countries. The titles and participants need to be identified in the application and the topic of the *panel* cannot be confined to a single Slavic language or culture. There may also be 1-2 designated discussants. As with all ICS papers, papers from panels must be published before the Congress; publication is the responsibility of the panel organizer. Participants in panels will not be included in the “national quotas” for participants. Send submission of Proposals for Panels (*bloky*) to Dr. L. Minova-Gjurkova (lmgjurkova@msk.edu.mk); application “forms” will be “published” on the website.

The designated themes for the XIV International Congress of Slavists, as well as other information, can be found on the ICS website at www.msk.edu.mk (currently only in Macedonian and Russian under “Documents”; minutes of Executive meetings can also be found under “Activities”).

The number of participants from each country has not yet been determined, but it is expected that the same 8 or so places will be allotted to Canadian participants.

The following timetable has been set, in conjunction with the editor of *Canadian Slavonic Papers*, which will publish Canadian contributions in the double issue No. 1-2 for 2008.

- 1st Sept. 2006: Preliminary (non-binding) indication of interest in participation (please contact the ICS Canadian representative Nick Žekulin at zekulin@ucalgary.ca indicating under which “theme” you anticipate submitting a proposal. This will assist in the battle for allocated slots that will take place at the Executive meeting in Udine, Italy later in September).
- 1st May 2007: Submission of title and abstract to ICS Canadian representative (for forwarding to *Canadian Slavonic Papers* and to ICS).
- 1st Sept. 2007: Submission of complete paper to *Canadian Slavonic Papers*
- 1st Feb. 2008: Decision of *Canadian Slavonic Papers* communicated to submitters
- 1st Apr. 2008: Deadline for revisions (if any)

Sept. 2008: XIV International Congress of Slavists, Ochrid, Macedonia. (The exact dates have not yet been set, but it is likely to be at the beginning of September.)
