



Dichotomy: division of an issue into two simple positions caused by black-and-white & either/or thinking


TOWARD A SOLUTION

Teleology: <u>belief</u> that the world has plan and purpose Dysteleology: <u>belief</u> that the world has NO plan and purpose Evolution: scientific theory that natural processes over billions of years produced all living organisms, including humans Creation: <u>belief</u> that the world is the product of the Creator

B. Science-Religion Relationship




Intelligent Design: <u>belief</u> that the beauty, complexity, and functionality in nature point to an Intelligent Designer
