•CREATION in Genesis 1:

"according to their kinds"

 Ancient Phenomenological Perspective bird kinds, fish kinds, cow kinds, etc

•Taxonomy-of-the-day

Ancient Taxonomy - Ancient Science

•REPRODUCTION:

"according to their kinds"

Origins Implication:

cow row original cow

Retrojection:

Taking present experience and casting it back in time to explain the past

CSI thinking

Reconstructing the past by using the present. (Latin: *retro*: back, backwards; *jacere*: to cast, throw)

De Novo Creation of Life

Creation in Genesis 1:

Living organisms were created **Quick** & **Complete**.

Retrojection of ancient taxonomy

Living organisms were separate "kinds"

Living organisms reproduced "according to their kinds"

- Adam = 3 Tiers
- •Adam is simply a retrojective conclusion (de novo creation "according to their kinds") of an ancient taxonomy, which is based on an ancient phenomenological perspective of biology.

Evolutionary Creation (2008):
