## UofA's GIS Day 2007 keynote speaker is Dr. Michael Batty.

Dr. Michael Batty, a pioneer of both GIS research and education, is former Director of the <u>NSF National Center for Geographic Information and Analysis (NCGIA)</u> and current Director of the <u>Centre for Advanced Spatial Analysis (CASA)</u>, University College London.

Dr. Batty's talk, "**The Virtual City: 3D GIS, Web-Based Geography and Multimedia**", focuses on the creation and applications of Virtual London, a large scale 3D iconic model of Greater London. Dr. Batty will also explore the innovative ways that this project is integrating popular technologies including **Google Earth** and **Second Life** to open the door to outside user experimentation with Virtual London, and will discuss how these endeavors may faciliate both public and professional engagement in urban planning and design.
