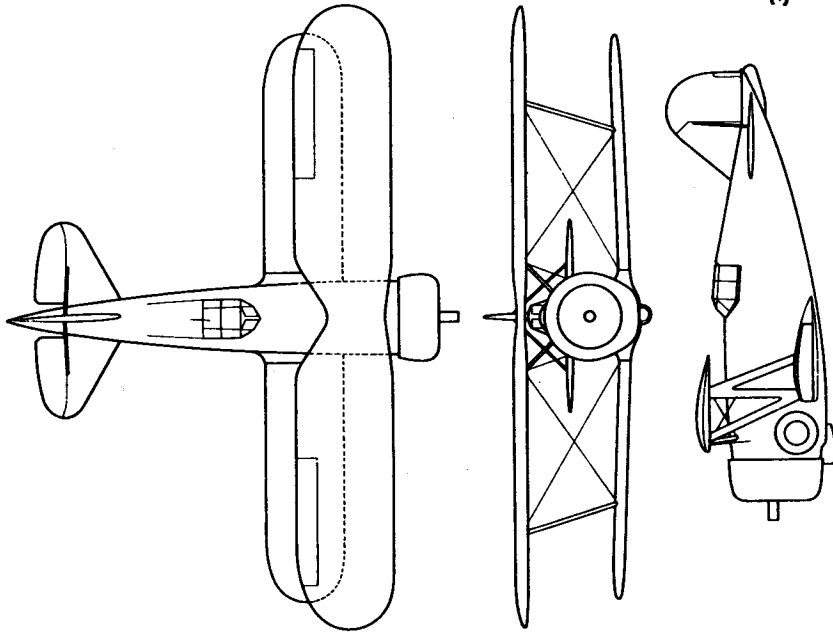


STREAMLINE ALL WING STRUTS

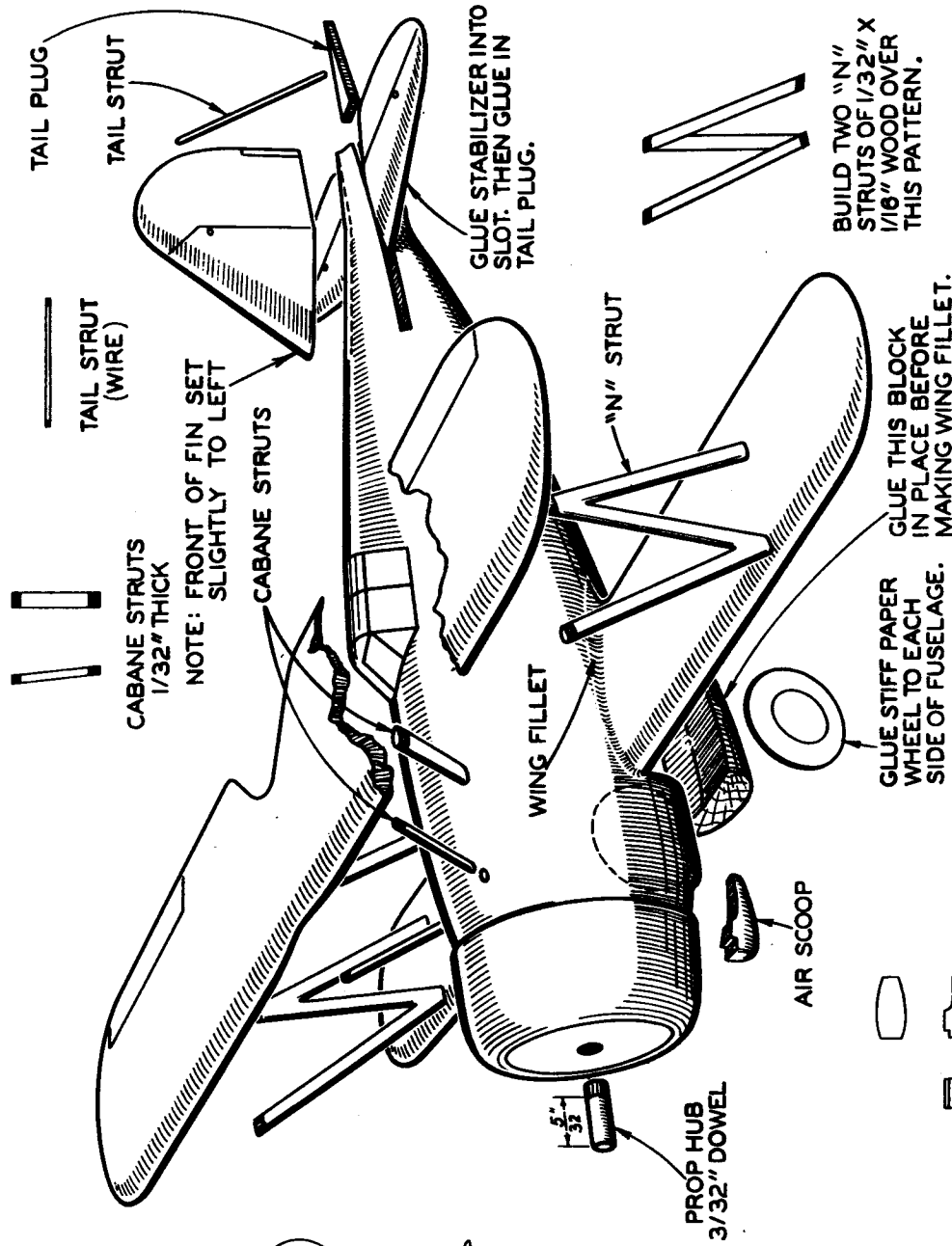


**GRUMMAN F3F-2**

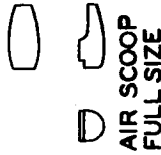
A single-place, U. S. Navy fighter, adaptable to operation from aircraft carriers. Many of these planes have seen service with the Marines. Retractable wheels fold to sides of fuselage. Span 32', Length 23' 3".

*Identification*

Biplane with parallel, staggered wings, the lower one having shorter span and chord. Upper wing has a deep "bite" in trailing edge at center, and slight indentation directly forward in entering edge. Interplane "N" struts. Stubby fuselage with small "greenhouse" aft of wings. Large tail surfaces.



GLUE STIFF PAPER WHEEL TO EACH SIDE OF FUSELAGE. GLUE THIS BLOCK IN PLACE BEFORE MAKING WING FILLET.
