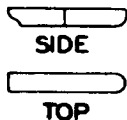
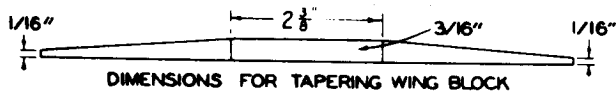


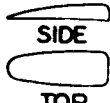
VOUGHT SIKORSKY SB2U-3

The "Vindicator" is a two-place scout and dive-bomber, used by the U.S. Navy for aircraft carrier service. Also used by the English, who call it the "Chesapeake." The SB2U-3 seaplane is mounted on twin floats and has an additional ventral fin beneath fuselage at rear. It is powered with a 750-H.P. Pratt & Whitney "Twin Wasp" Junior. Span 41' 10 5/8"; length 33' 11 3/4".

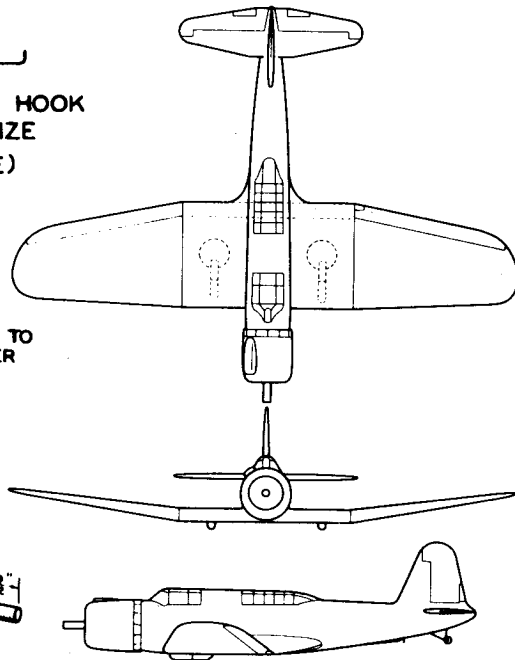


FULL SIZE "KNEE"
MAKE 2

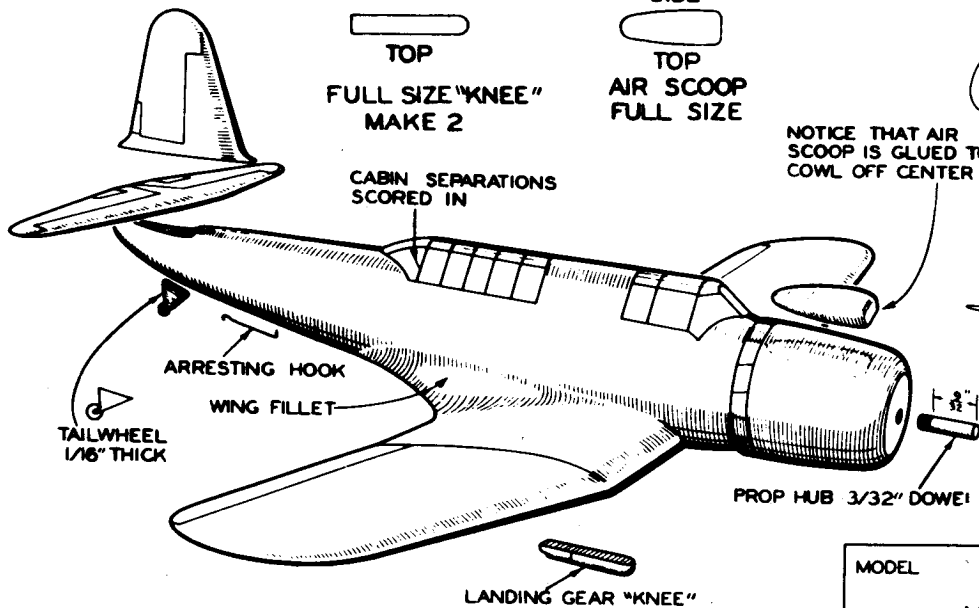


FULL SIZE
