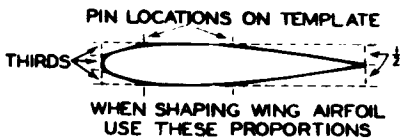
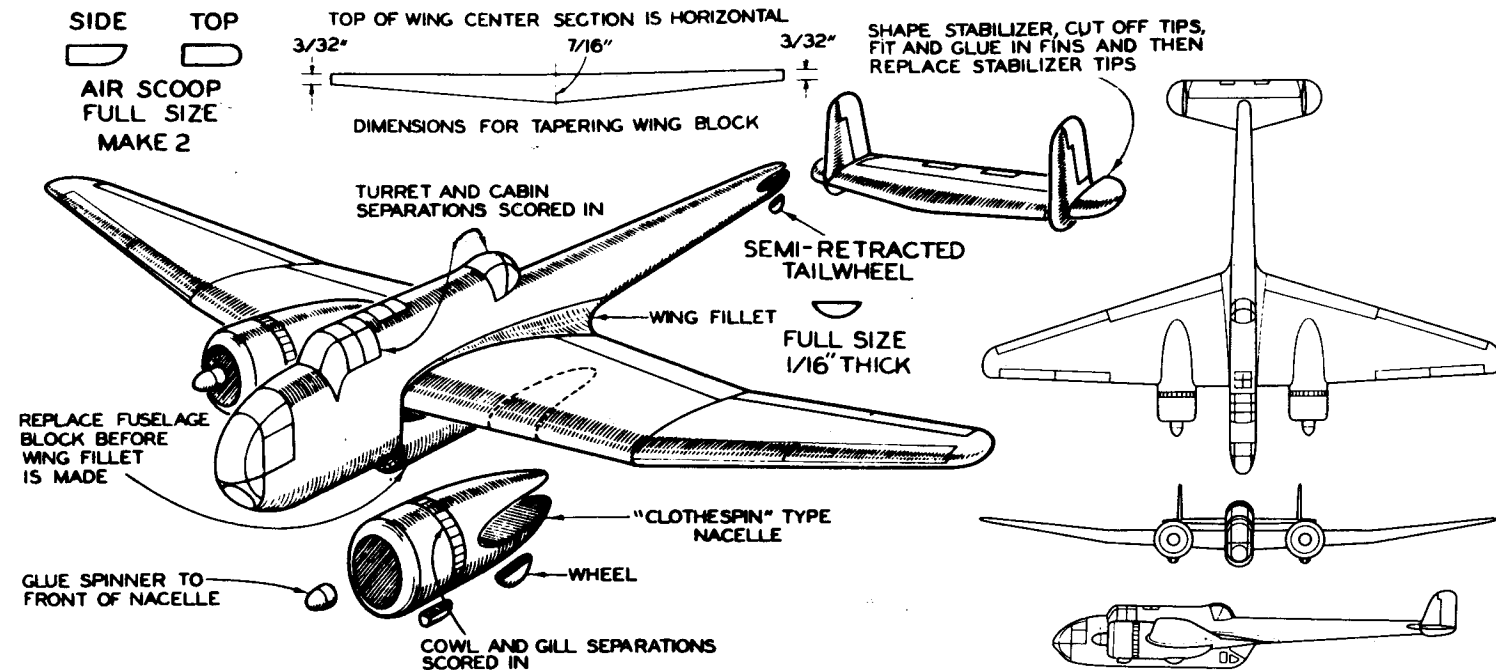


# HANDLEY PAGE "HAMPDEN"

A twin-engined medium bomber carrying a crew of four. Its armament consists of six machine guns, and in addition it carries a bomb load inside the fuselage. The "Hampden" is powered by two 980-H.P. Bristol 9-cyl. radial air-cooled engines. The Handley Page "Hereford" is identical in appearance to the Hampden except that it is powered by two liquid-cooled engines resulting in slightly different nacelle appearance. Span 69' 2"; length 53' 7".
