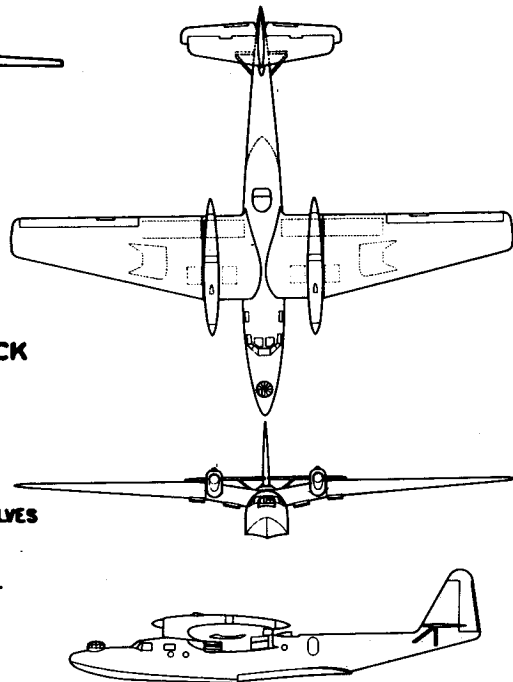
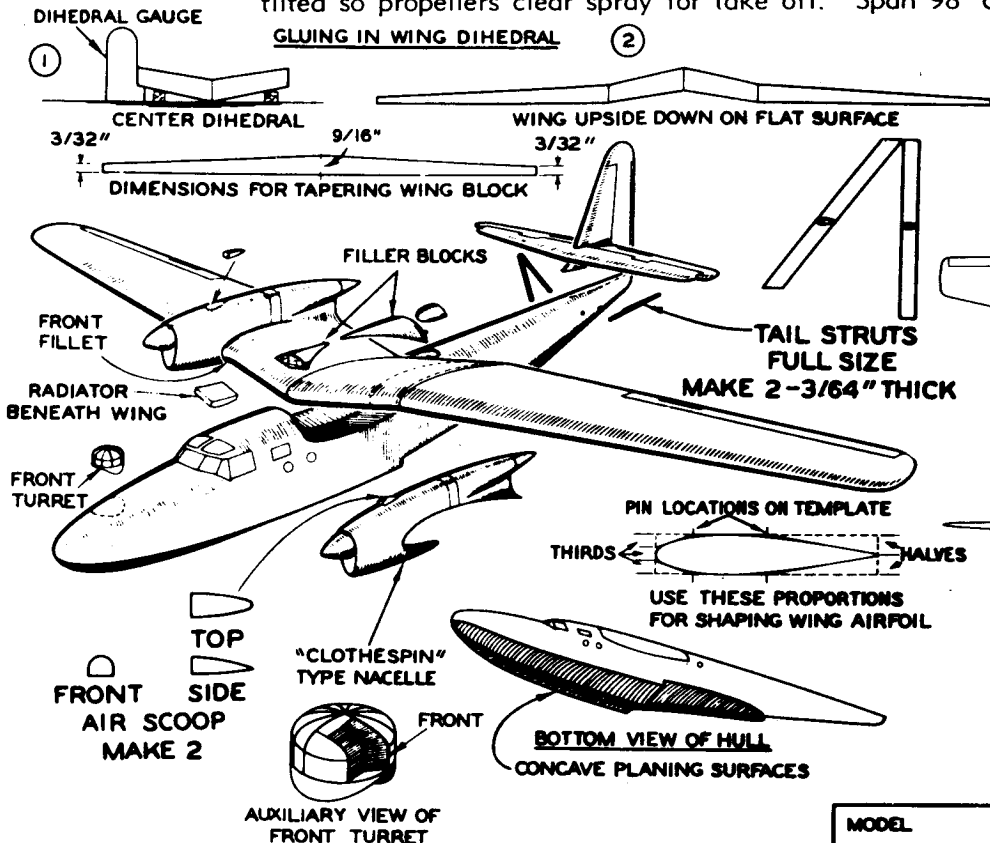


DORNIER Do-26

A long-range flying boat originally reported as developed for North Atlantic Mail service but now in use as a patrol bomber.

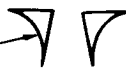
Powered by four liquid-cooled Junkers "Jumo" diesel engines. Rear engines can be tilted so propellers clear spray for take off. Span 98' 6"; length 80' 6".
