



INTERESTING FACTS

The Curtiss "Helldiver" has recently gone into service against the Japanese held mandated islands. It is one of the largest single engined planes and carries a heavy bomb-load entirely enclosed in a bomb-bay. This model is of the land or carrier-based design. The Army has adopted this type and designates it the "A-25".

IDENTIFICATION

Low-mid monoplane with dihedral from wide root. Leading edge straight, trailing edge tapers to wide-rounded tips. Tailplane similar in shape, but reversed. Oval cowl, deep fuselage, long greenhouse; large high fin and "C-shaped for Curtiss" rudder.
