ELEGIBILITY

- (a) The scholarship is open to full-time undergraduate students completing the third or fourth year in the Faculty of Education at the University of Alberta.
- (b) Applicants are to have taken at least one course in language acquisition or teaching and one senior course in Ukrainian language or literature. One of these courses must be taken during the academic year in which application for the award is made.
- (c) An overall grade-point average of “B+” is required. Both academic standing and demonstrated involvement in the Ukrainian community will be considered in choosing the successful applicant.
- (d) The Canadian Institute of Ukrainian Studies administers the award for the Ukrainian Canadian Professional and Business Club of Edmonton.
- (e) The deadline for receipt of the complete application by the Canadian Institute of Ukrainian Studies is 1 March (or the following Monday if 1 March falls on a Saturday or Sunday).

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Applications will be judged on a points system (maximum 15) that emphasizes academic achievement but also takes other factors into consideration:

- Overall academic record (grades and past awards) (0-4)
- Performance in Ukrainian language and literature courses (0-4)
- Performance in language acquisition and teaching courses (0-4)
- Community involvement (0-3)
