## ELIGIBILITY

- (a) The fellowship is open to all students enrolled in a doctoral program in one of the following areas: education, history, law, humanities, arts, social sciences, women's studies, library sciences, women's studies, library sciences. Applications in other areas will be considered on an individual basis. The dissertation itself must be on a Ukrainian or Ukrainian-Canadian topic.
- (b) Because funding is for completion of the dissertation, all other degree requirements must be completed by the time the award is taken up (usually September or January of the funding year).
- (c) The value of the fellowship cannot exceed \$12,500 in any given year; fellowship holders may apply for a one-year renewal.
- (d) Canadian citizens, permanent residents of Canada, and foreign students are eligible; they may also hold the award at any institution of higher learning. For evaluation criteria, see below.
- (e) The deadline for receipt of the complete application by the Canadian Institute of Ukrainian Studies is 1 March (or the following Monday if 1 March falls on a Saturday or a Sunday).
- (f) The award recipient agrees to deposit a copy of the finished dissertation with the Canadian Institute of Ukrainian Studies, which ordinarily reserves first right of publication.

## EVALUATION CRITERIA

Applications will be judged on a points system (maximum 20) that emphasizes academic merit but also takes other factors into consideration:

Dissertation proposal (0-4)

Letters of reference (0-4)

Writing sample (0-4)

Academic grades (0-3)

Publishing record/conference papers (0-3)

Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada (2)

Foreign student enrolled at the University of Alberta (1)
