SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTIONS

DYSCORPIA: Future Intersections of the Body and Technology

Since late 2017, Oliver has led a large interdisciplinary University of Alberta team on a research creation project which explores future intersections of the body and technology. In 2019 this culminated in a large exhibition at

Enterprise Square Galleries, Edmonton, accompanied by a large exhibition catalogue. In 2020, there was a second virtual exhibition (Dyscorpia 2.1) with contributions for over 60 artists. DY3CORPIA was conceived and presented during COVID as an online exhibition in 2021. DY3CORPIA was exhibited in a fully navigable virtual copy of Enterprise Square Galleries where the first Dyscorpia took place. This project has received generous support from a SSHRC Connections Grant, Edmonton Arts Council, President's Fund grants and a KIAS Team grant. Oliver is currently awaiting results of a SSHRC IDG application to fund the next iteration of Dyscorpia called DYSCORP(AI): Living with and within AI which will focus on the body and artificial intelligence.

Know Thyself as a Virtual Reality

Know Thyself as a Virtual Reality is a KIAS funded, interdisciplinary project that focuses on the ethics and aesthetics of the use of medical data and virtual reality. The project unfolded in a series of meetings, workshops, and creative endeavors to produce multiple outcomes. An ethics eSymposium in Summer 2021 brought researchers together to cross-pollinate research across the disciplines of computer science, digital humanities (ethics of AI, and race/gender bias in computer visualization), fine arts (focused on artistic use of medical imaging), nursing (focused on computer literacy and the impact of digitized health records), radiology (full body, 3D/4D MR and ultrasound) and rehabilitation medicine and reflect on best practices for working with sensitive data in creative research. This eSymposium informed the publicly available document *Best Practices for Working Artistically with Sensitive Data*.

Two research creation projects, My Data Body and Your Data Body, were created by the interdisciplinary team to better explore and exemplify the important ethical and aesthetic issues at stake in the field of body scan imaging. These VR projects were exhibited as part of the exhibition *Know Thyself as a Virtual Reality* exhibition at FAB Gallery, Edmonton in February 2023 along with five other VR artworks created by invited artists as part of the KTVR project. Connected to this project, Oliver received a SSHRC (Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council) Insight Development Grant to create two virtual reality artworks My Data Body and Your Data Body.

TEDMED 2018

Oliver was invited to be a main stage speaker at TEDMED in Palm Springs, USA.

LASERAlberta Speaker Series Oliver is a LASERAlberta host (Leonardo Art Science Evening Rendezvous). LASERs are part of Leonardo's international program of evening gatherings that bring artists and scientists together for informal presentations and conversations. Since 2017, Oliver has organized and presented 11 LASERAlberta events.

Collaborations with Van Grimde Corps Secrets Since 2011, Oliver has been working with contemporary dance choreographer Isabelle Van Grimde of VGCS. In 2011, Van Grimde commissioned *Melanix.Execute*, an interactive video installation of a de-fleshing scanned body that her dancers interacted with via an XBOX Kinekt as part of her creation *The Body in Question(s)*. In 2018, Van Grimde embarked on Eve 2050 project, a contemporary dance project which speculated the body in 2050 through a web series, interactive installation and stage production to which Oliver contributed sculptural works, costume accessories and digital files. Eve 2050, which was awarded the Numix Award in 2020, has been presented across Canada and Europe, most notably at Muffatwerk, Munich and ZKM, Kahlsruhe. In 2022 *Messis*, a new web series by Van Grimde and DAVAI which features sculptures and digital assets by Oliver was launched. Oliver is currently working with VGCS on two new projects Transes and MutationsAI that will be presented at Agora de la danse, Montreal in 2024 and 2026.
