In last week's bulletin I shared the good news that the residences were fully booked for the fall. Now some good news about our enrolment numbers: As of the start of this past week, our total in all SJC courses for the coming year (May 2024–April 2025) was 2296 students, while at this time last year, our total number of students enrolled was 1776. So we're over 500 students ahead of where we were this time last year!
