REDUCED CAPACITY AT ALL MASSES

The restrictions imposed due to the health emergency on Wednesday, September 15 caught the University community by surprise; all in-person activities were either cancelled or moved online until the following Monday. My apologies to anyone who was blindsided by the cancellation of in-person masses at SJC.

The bottom line is that we now have to enforce social distancing at all masses. People from different households have to be 2 metres apart, and the capacity of the chapel is capped at 40. The geometry of the chapel allows up to 24 distanced individuals, with only two unrelated people per pew. However, you can bring your whole family (if they fit in one pew) by signing up for two slots.

All registered parishioners should have received an email giving a link to the signup form. If you sign up for mass one weekend, we ask that you wait a few days to sign up the following week, so everyone has a chance.

Forms are in the lobby (on the top of the pamphlet pillar where the coat rack is), or you can find it on the SJC website.
