CALLED TO PROTECT

Called to Protect training, an abuse prevention training session will be offered on Friday September 08, 1:00 to 3:30 pm.

This training is not because we think that our volunteers might otherwise abuse children. It's so that everyone ministering in the Archdiocese is aware of the relevant policies and procedures, and is empowered to speak up if they see something sketchy going on.

A lot of it might seem like common sense, but abuse occurred in many places because people didn't recognize the signs, or didn't know what to do about it. It is very important that this not happen again.
