### Good Friday, March 29, 2024, 10 am, 99 Street and 107 Avenue

The Outdoor Way of the Cross is an ecumenical prayer event marking the suffering and death of Jesus. It is a time to reflect on how the gospel values of Jesus apply to individual and public life today. This year's theme, "Journeying Home" is based on Isaiah 58:6-7: "Is not this the fast that I choose... to share your bread with the hungry and bring the homeless into your house."

People of all faith traditions are welcome. The 1.5-kilometre walk is reasonable for most ages and ability levels. Free street parking is available near the start location. Light refreshments will be provided at Hope Mission (106 Avenue and 99 Street) after the final station.
