## **Value and Number of Awards:**

- \$2,000
- Minimum of two awards offered, annually

## **Eligibility:**

- Open to all undergraduate students who will have completed at least one year of full-time study in any faculty or program at a post-secondary institution in Alberta. Applicants from post-secondary institutions in other provinces or territories of Canada may also apply, but preference is given to students from Alberta in the adjudication process.
- Applicants must have completed an accredited Ukrainian language program (or equivalent) at the senior high school level, such as:
  - Ukrainian Language 10, 20, and 30,
  - Program at IFSUS,
  - Ukrainian Language and Culture courses,
  - Equivalent courses, either at the high school or post-secondary level.
- Graduates of the IFSUS program will be given preference in the adjudication process.
- Applicants are required to enroll in a Ukrainian studies course or program to be offered in Ukraine by an accredited post-secondary institution.

## **Adjudication of Awards:**

- Applications will be judged on a points system (maximum 20) based on:
  - 1) Overall academic merit (0 – 5 points),
  - 2) Performance in Ukrainian language/studies courses (0 – 5 points)
  - 3) One-page essay describing the course/program to be undertaken in Ukraine, with an explanation of how this may be of benefit to the student (0 – 2 points),
  - 4) Involvement in the Ukrainian community (0 – 3 points),
  - 5) Letters of recommendation (0 – 2 points),
  - 6) Student from Alberta (1 point),
  - 7) Graduate of IFSUS (2 points),
  - 8) In the event of a tie score, IFSUS graduates receive preference.
- Transcripts from high school(s) and post-secondary institution(s) must be submitted.
- Two letters of recommendation are required.
