



Early Final Admission for High School Students

What is Early Final Admission?

The University of Alberta is piloting an **Early Final** admission to top **Alberta high school** students including International students in Alberta on study permit, applying for **Fall 2011**. Students can take advantage of **Early Final** admission which is a **final** offer of admission before grade 12 courses are completed, when applying to a first choice program in one of the following Faculties:

- Agricultural, Life and Environmental Sciences;
- Arts;
- Augustana;
- Native Studies;
- Nursing;
- Physical Education and Recreation;
- Saint-Jean;
- Science

What do you need to be considered?

- A minimum average of 90% in a combination of 5 completed grade 11 and grade 12 courses with final grades, applicable for their first choice program;
- Final grades in at least 2 grade 12 courses required for the first choice program. If additional final grades are available they may be used;
- Registration in the remainder of the 5 required grade 12 courses. Where provided, interim grades in these courses may be used in the calculation of the admission average;
- High School Grade Report sent directly from the high school (Grade Reports will not be accepted from students). Grade Reports must include the student's full name, birth date, signature of a school official, and school stamp or seal

Faxed Grade Reports must be received directly from the high school on school letterhead, with stamp and signature.

When will students hear?

- As soon as first term grades are available students are advised to have their Grade Report submitted by the high school. Offers will be made on an ongoing basis, until May 30th.

Next Steps

- Students are strongly encouraged to complete their grade 12 courses and maintain their academic standing as these courses are often prerequisites to ensure success in UofA courses.

What are the Benefits of Early Final Admission?

- Students will be automatically considered and guaranteed an Academic Excellence Award of at least \$2,000. For more information visit www.ualberta.ca/awards/academicexcellence. There are additional entrance awards which can be found at www.ualberta.ca/awards.
- Students will be assigned a personal Faculty advisor to answer questions and guide them through the next steps.

Important Notes:

- Students offered Early Admission which is based on completed or in progress grade 12 courses and grades may still be considered for **Early Final Admission**.
- Students who are not eligible for **Early Final Admission** will be notified and final admission will be determined upon receipt of all grade 12 results.
- IB Diploma students will be considered for an early final admission based on IB Predicted Grades.
- Through **ApplyAlberta** the University of Alberta can obtain final grade 12 transcripts from Alberta Education, on behalf of students.
- International students on study permit must have met the English Language Proficiency including Spoken English Proficiency, where required.
