

AFNS Graduate Student Community Leadership Award

Value: One award of \$250 plus certificate

Eligibility: One award to an AFNS Graduate Student who has improved the quality of life in the Department of Agricultural, Food and Nutritional Science (AFNS).

Terms of Reference: The purpose of this award is to recognize a graduate student who helped organize or substantially contributed to an event or idea that improved the quality of life in AFNS. This is not an academic award.

Award Criteria: Submitted for nomination by an individual or group (not the nominee). The application should be a one page document listing each volunteer activity or evidence of leadership. Include details on the student's role, the audience and how each activity contributed to community life or improved the social environment in AFNS.

Deadline Date: First Monday in December each year.
