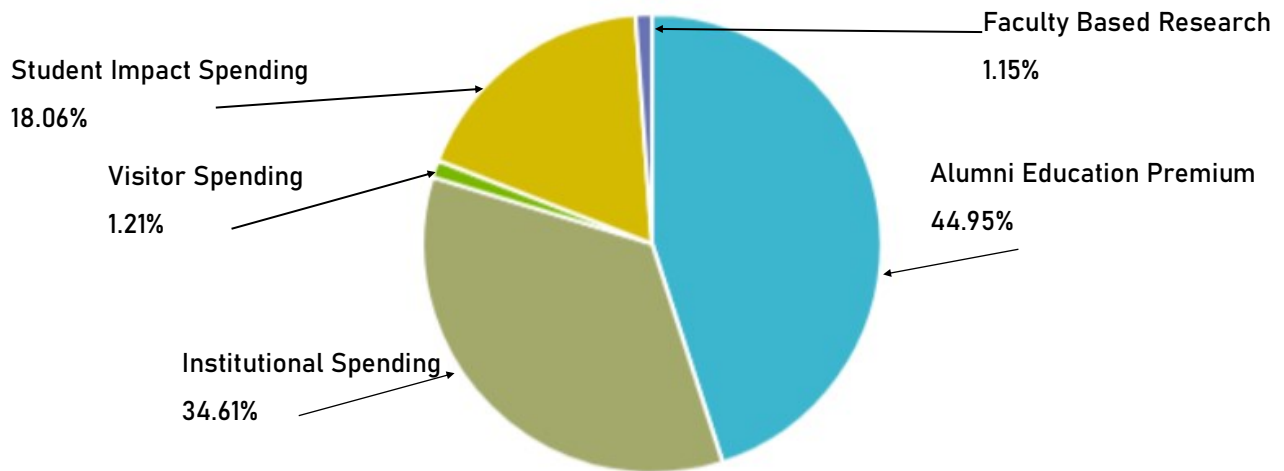

 <p>The Alumni Education Premium <i>The additional earnings from all graduates from 2007 onward.</i></p>	<p>\$50.25 Million <i>Equal to 628 jobs at \$80,000 per year.</i></p>
 <p>Institutional Spending <i>The Faculty's direct operating expenditures (salaries, supplies, services, scholarships, and awards).</i></p>	<p>\$38.7 Million <i>Equal to 645 new vehicles at \$40,000 each.</i></p>
 <p>Visitor Spending <i>Family and friends visiting throughout the year.</i></p>	<p>\$1.36 Million <i>Equal to 200 all inclusive trips to the beautiful Bahamas for a family of four.</i></p>
 <p>Student Impact Spending <i>Impact of daily Augustana Faculty students.</i></p>	<p>\$20.2 Million <i>Equal to 250 jobs at \$80,000 per year.</i></p>
 <p>Faculty-Based Research <i>Research grants and contracts to support student research assistants, travel publications, and conference/workshop activity.</i></p>	<p>\$1.29 Million <i>Equal to 71,000 paid research assistant hours.</i></p>

About the Augustana Faculty (since 2007)

- ~1000 Students registered per year
- 5% of graduates reside within 50km of Camrose
- 73% of graduates remain in Alberta
- ~360 employees in 2018-19
