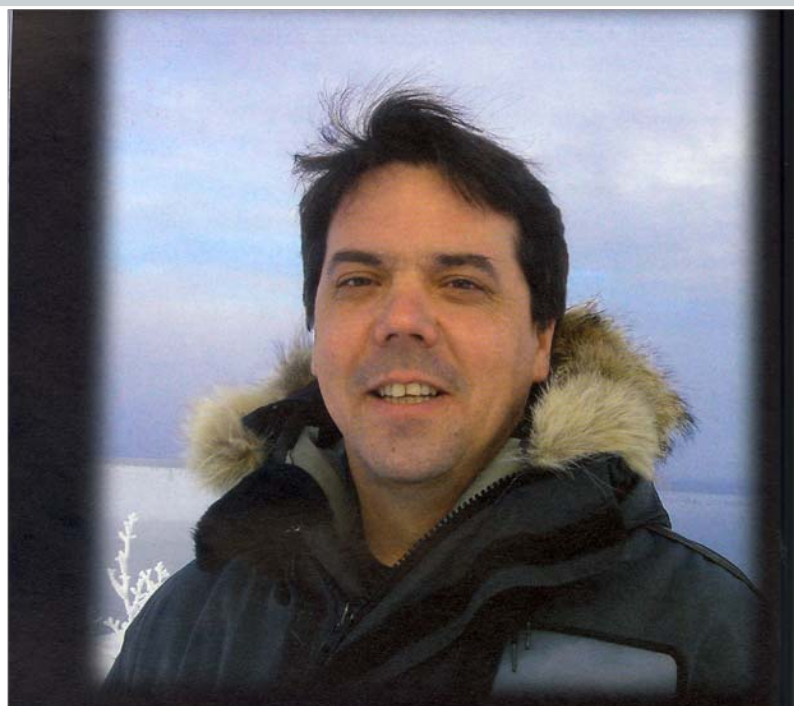


**Michelle Daveluy**

Anthropologue/ Anthropologist • Canada

*Michelle Daveluy* est professeur d'anthropologie à l'Université d'Alberta. Ethnolinguiste spécialisée dans la langue inuktitut, elle est membre du comité d'organisation de l'École doctorale internationale pour les études des sociétés arctiques, une collaboration unique entre des chercheurs et des habitants du Grand Nord. Elle est l'auteur de nombreux essais et d'un film remarqué, « Anaulatag, jouer pour ne pas perdre ».

*Michelle Daveluy* is a professor of anthropology at the University of Alberta in Edmonton. An ethnolinguist specializing in the Inuktitut language, she is a member of the steering committee of the International PhD School for the Study of Arctic Societies, a unique collaboration between researchers, professors and inhabitants of the High North. She has written numerous essays and made an acclaimed film, 'Anaulatag: Trying not to lose'.



**Christopher Fletcher**

Anthropologue/ Anthropologist • Canada

*Christopher Fletcher* est professeur d'anthropologie à l'Université d'Alberta et à l'Institut circumpolaire canadien, un centre interdisciplinaire spécialisé dans l'étude des communautés durables et la connaissance des régions circumpolaires. Ses recherches portent principalement sur les communautés inuit. Il travaille actuellement sur les esquimaux de Deline, dans la région des Territoires du Nord-Ouest au Canada.

*Christopher Fletcher* is an associate professor of anthropology at the University of Alberta and an associate of the Canadian Circumpolar Institute (CCI). The CCI is an interdisciplinary centre that focuses on sustainable communities and advancing the overall understanding of the circumpolar regions. He has worked throughout the Canadian north with Inuit and First Nations communities and is now working with the Sahtu Dene of Deline, NWT.

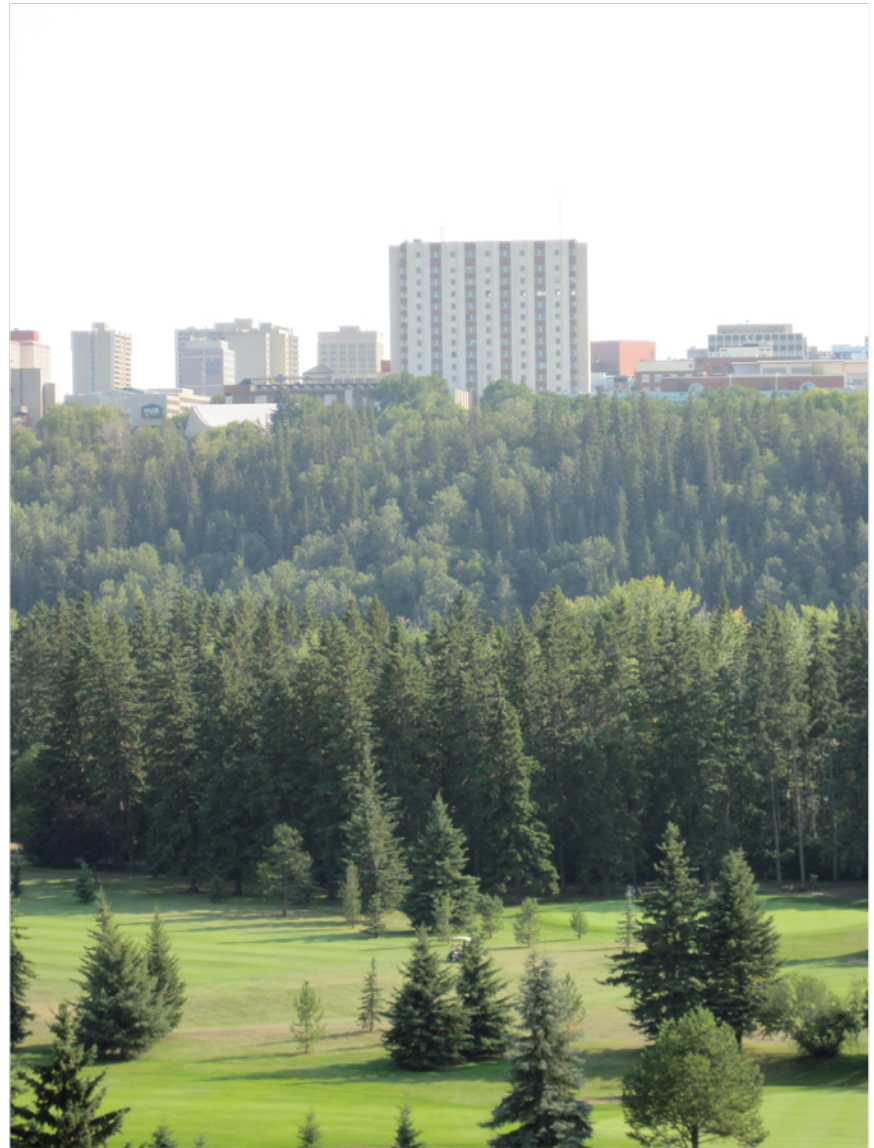
