The accreditation review was successfully completed and the Committee on Accreditation granted continued accreditation for seven years, the maximum amount. The next comprehensive review visit is scheduled for spring 2020.

The first cohort of the online MLIS program was admitted for September 2013 with 50 students. A SLIS student won the prestigious Ivy A Thompson Graduate Scholarship. This scholarship is worth \$18,000 and only two are awarded each year to graduate students in the University of Alberta. The University's budget situation is still unclear but Dean Fern Snart is prepared for budget cuts and SLIS will not be affected.
