## PROGRAM PLANNING FAQ

This document is not comprehensive. It is the student's responsibility to consult the Art and Design website and Beartracks for complete program requirements and pre-/corequisite information.

## General Reminders

- You must complete a minimum of 24 credits (eight 3-credit classes) in the Fall/Winter Session in order to stay in the program. For exceptions, please see website and consult with your advisor.
- You need a minimum 2.7 GPA in all courses taken in Fall/Winter Session for promotion to the next year of this program.
- Final-year requirements include a minimum 2.7 GPA on the last *27 taken toward the degree and Departmental recommendation.
- You need a minimum grade of B-(2.7) averaged between the relevant prerequisite courses in order to proceed to the next level. (See HADVC for exception)
- A minimum of 30 credits must be completed while registered in the BFA program.
- "Senior" level means 200-level courses or higher.


## Studio Courses

- When taking 6 credit studio courses, you must register in the same section in both terms. e.g. ART 422A(C1) and 422B(C1), or DES 337A(A2) and 337B(A2).
- The 500-level ART (*12) and 300-level HADVC (*3) program requirements must be taken at the University of Alberta.


## HADVC Courses

- You must complete at least two 200-level HADVC courses with a minimum grade of B(2.7) in each to proceed to 300 level HADVC courses.
- HADVC 100 is not a prerequisite for HADVC 200-level classes.


## ARTS/SCIENCE OPTIONS

- Arts and Science options are met with any courses within the Faculty of Arts or Faculty of Science except ART, DES or HADVC classes. The only exception is the Arts/Science option in final year (refer to checklist on other side).
- You may replace up to two of your Arts/Science options (6 credits) with courses from Faculties other than Arts or Science. (If you are doing your BFA as an after degree, you do not have this option.)
