Welcome to the University of Alberta, Augustana Campus! We have prepared some information below to help you find your way to campus from the Edmonton International Airport.

GETTING TO CAMROSE FROM THE EDMONTON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (FLYEIA.COM)

New first year *international students will be reimbursed a maximum of \$100 by Augustana for the cost of a taxi to Camrose from the Edmonton International Airport. Please get a receipt from the taxi driver with the amount of the fare paid, the name of the taxi company, and your name clearly written on the receipt. Beginning January 6 bring your receipt to Corinne in 2-38 Founders' Hall for reimbursement. The deadline to submit taxi receipts for reimbursement is February 28, 2020.

*Undergraduate students who are not Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents, or Convention Refugees or Protected Persons as defined by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada.

NEED TO EXCHANGE MONEY?

Make sure that you have sufficient Canadian currency available before hiring the services of any taxi. Automated teller machines are located throughout the airport terminal for convenient banking. International Currency Exchange (ICE) is available at the airport:

You can take a taxi from the Edmonton International Airport to Camrose. The journey to Camrose from the Airport should take approximately one hour.



Peer Program

WHY JOIN THE PROGRAM?

Participating as a Peer is a great way to meet fellow students who are familiar with the University of Alberta, and who want to share their experiences and resources with you. Senior Peers have often faced the same situations and challenges as you, and they can provide casual advice to help you have a successful academic career.

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

Throughout the academic year, Senior Peers (mentors) offer social support, assistance, and guidance, through one-on-one meetings, and social activities. They share personal experiences with new international students (mentees) that ease the transition to university.
