











Trends in China's Birth rate



China's Aging Population




Changes in China's Labor Force to 2014


Air and water pollution cost 5.8 percent of GDP per year (World Bank and SEPA)

Birth defects rose from 91 per 10,000 in 1997, to 171 per 10,000 in 2008 (Beijing Municipal Health Bureau



China's Energy Generating Capacity 2014





Planned Changes in China's Energy Capacity: Additions and Retirements





10 key industries: Information technology; Numerical control tools and robotics; Aerospace equipment; Ocean engineering equipment and high-tech ships; Railway equipment; Energy saving and new energy vehicles; Power equipment; New materials; Medicine and medical devices; and Agricultural machinery



Milestones:

- Increase R&D spend as a percentage of sales from 0.95% to 1.68%
- Increase labor productivity annually by 7.5% to 2020 and by 6.5% annually thereafter
- Reduce energy consumption per unit of added value by 35% by 2025
- Reduce water consumption per unit of added value by 35% by 2025




Comparing RCEP and TPP

RCEP

- Asia –Pacific oriented
- Service trade and investment
- Economic and technical cooperation
- Trade standards in Asia-Pacific
- IP and legal matters

TPP

- North America oriented
- Customs and trade facilitations; Trade remedies
- Sanitary and phytosanitary measures
- Technical barriers to trade
- Service trade, investment, ecommerce
- IP, labour and environmental standards; Dispute mechanisms

TPP is said to have the higher standards for transparency, and trade rules.

RCEP is China – centric whereas TPP is US – centric.
