3. ECON 102 or Macro Economics (3 ucw)
4. MATH 154 or Calculus (3 ucw)
5. STAT 151 or Statistics (3 ucw)

## GPA Reporting

### Self-Record Your Term or Annual GPA's

#### What is a Term or Annual GPA?

GPA stands for grade point average. Most institutions provide some type of GPA calculation for students on their transcript. Please ensure you have a copy of your transcript available before proceeding.

A 'Term GPA' is the average of all grades within a specific academic term, for example, Fall term, Winter term, Spring term.

An 'Annual GPA' is the average of all grades within an academic year, for example, Fall 2019/Winter 2020.

The information collected will be used to calculate an average on your most recently completed course work in the most recent two terms or year of study if they contain a minimum of 24 units of course weight (ucw) or equivalent.
