- Career Support: Our Career Management Centre is here to help you with career guidance and support.







The value of the Alberta Executive MBA is based not only on the quality of the instruction in the classroom, but on the insights and experiences that our students bring themselves. Applicants for the Executive MBA are evaluated on how the program will help you achieve your professional goals and how the rest of the cohort will benefit from your participation. As such, the admissions committee views each application holistically and considers a wide range of factors in admission decisions.

Apply to the program

Candidates should have the support of their organizations to undertake the program. This support includes allowances for time away from work to attend class sessions. It may also include financial support through employee education assistance programs.

PROGRAM FEES

Total tuition and fees for the Alberta Executive MBA are **\$67,000**. These fees include tuition, a work tablet, books and course materials, meals and parking while attending classes and travel and accommodation for the International Study Tour. Tuition is due in four equal instalments at the beginning of each term in the program.
