Year One and Year Two in Medicine

Years one and two are divided into organ-system blocks:

- Introductory Block
- Infection, Immunity and Inflammation
- Endocrine System
- Cardiovascular, Pulmonary and Renal Systems
- Gastroenterology and Nutrition
- Reproductive Medicine and Urology
- Musculoskeletal System
- Neurosciences
- Oncology

Each block presents the material in a progression from basic science to clinical application.

Year Four

Third year medicine - Students are placed in the standard six main specialty rotations as well as elective experiences. Alternatively, students can undertake the Integrated Community Clerkship program followed by their electives.
