Wilson Climbing Centre Access Agreement:

All Access Agreements must be accompanied by a completed Waiver of Liability or Youth Informed Consent Form (for individuals under the age of 18). Access Agreements (and therefore Waiver of Liability/Youth Informed Consent Forms) are valid for a period of one year.

Patrons will only be permitted access to the Wilson Climbing Centre if both a current Waiver of Liability/Youth Informed Consent and current Access Agreement are on file (at the time of check-in). Student/Staff Term Passes, Recurring Memberships, and Drop-in Admissions are only valid if Access Agreement and Waiver of Liability/Youth Informed Consent are current.

All Access Agreements must be renewed on an annual basis. The renewal process involves the updating of Waiver of Liability/Youth Informed Consent Form, Access Agreement Form, and may require a re-test (in the case of Top Rope or Lead Climbing access).

Current photo identification (e.g. one-card, license, or passport) must be presented to the front desk at the time of check-in in order to validate current Access Agreement and Waiver of Liability/Youth Informed Consent. Patrons without a current Access Agreement and/or Waiver of Liability/Youth Informed Consent at the time of Check-in will not be permitted access to the Wilson Climbing Centre (until these forms are updated). Patrons without current photo identification at the time of check-in will not be permitted access to the Wilson Climbing Center.

The Supervisor, Assistant Supervisor, and Staff of the Wilson Climbing Centre reserve the right to revoke Access Agreements (and therefore access) to the Climbing Wall with or without warning and without refund for individuals deemed to be in violation of the posted facility rules and regulations.

Operational hours for the Wilson Climbing Centre are structured as follows: The facility operates with 4 distinct schedules: Fall (September-December), Winter (January-April), Spring (May-June), Summer (July- August). The Winter operational schedule is subject to the Winter Closure in December.

Special Events – the Wilson Climbing Centre schedule is subject to change based on any number of events taking place in the Physical and Wellness (PAW) building including but not limited to sporting events, clinics and competitions. Every attempt will be made to provide two weeks' notice of any alteration to the Wilson Climbing Centre's operational schedule.

All Wilson Climbing Centre patrons are expected to know and abide by the posted facility regulations.
