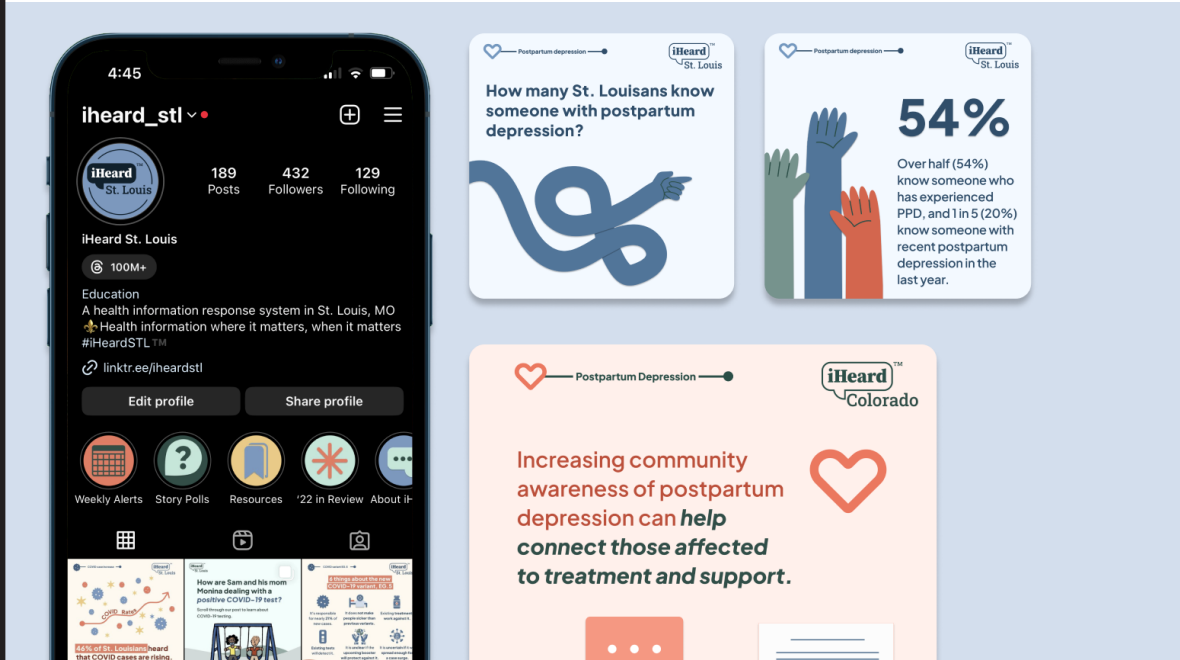


# Co-design Beyond Pandemics
