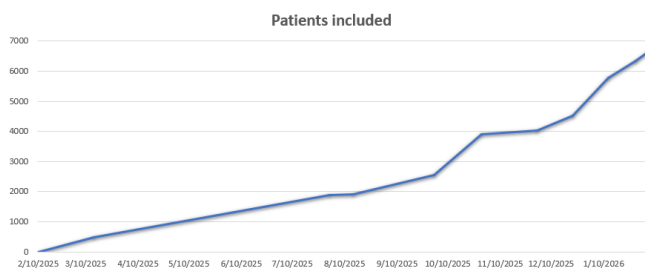
We are pleased to share with you the latest updates on the AKI-EPI 2 study.

Current Status

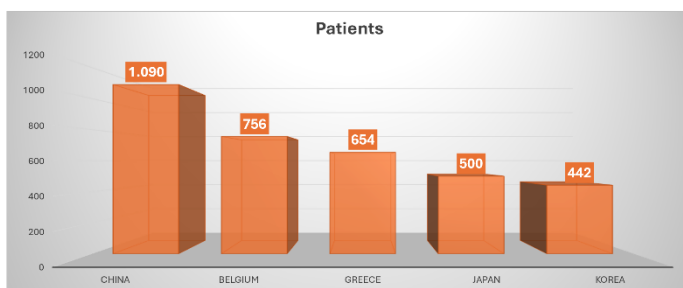
Since the ESICM meeting in München, the study has gained a real momentum as is illustrated in the figure below.

In the coming months we expect several additional countries and centers to join. We aim to **complete patient inclusion by the end of 2026**, which means centers should finalize administrative preparations to begin enrolment by **summer 2026**.

Data Quality Monitoring

To ensure high-quality data, the Lausanne team has begun **remote monitoring** of REDCap entries.

The current focus is on data completeness.

The monitoring team will reach out to you by email should any issues need clarification.

Long-Term Outcome: 1-Year Data Collection

As the study began in **February 2025**, the 1-year follow-up phase has now started.

A reminder for participating centers:

- ➡ Please collect outcome data **1 year (± 30 days)** after each patient's inclusion.

Important Information in the REDCap eCRF

To address recent questions, the following message has been added to the eCRF:

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please enroll **100 consecutive eligible ICU patients**:

- Do **not** create an eCRF for non-eligible patients
- Include ICU patients **regardless of whether they have AKI**

100-Patient Limit per Centre

Please respect the limit of **100 patients per center**.

We have noticed that some enthusiastic centers have surpassed this number, and we kindly ask everyone to adhere to the cap to ensure balanced representation
