

INFLUENZA SEASON IS UPON US AND THAT MEANS SO IS OUR SEASONAL IMMUNIZATION CAMPAIGN!!

❖ The Site Immunization Campaign will launch Oct 8th -Oct 31.

- ❖ No patient should get influenza from our staff while in our care. Without the protection of the vaccine, you are not immune.
- ❖ You can spread influenza to your patients, coworkers, loved ones and community one day before you know you are sick.
- ❖ Getting immunized is crucial to making our workplaces safe and healthy for our patients and each other.

Important Information to Note:



You will require to bring your AHS ID and Personal Health Number (this is a provincial requirement – without it we can't immunize you). Your PHN can be a physical copy, photo, or memorized number.



On site Rexall & KEC Outpatient Pharmacies will be immunizing both public and staff. Their campaign will run October 20-24 Monday-Friday 0830-1630 in their respective atriums. They will have both regular and high dose vaccine. **There is no Covid Vaccine available through the pharmacy.**

Site Influenza Immunizers

- ❖ We will have stationary pop-up stations throughout the site to assist in immunizing all Staff and Physicians.
- ❖ Hours will vary by program.
- ❖ They will encompass days, evenings, and weekends!
- ❖ Immunization hours will be adjusted to accommodate night staff.
- ❖ **The immunizers will only be administering the flu vaccine and not any Covid immunizations.**



WHS Clinics

- ❖ **NEW:** Clinics offered are by **Drop -in Only this year,** no appointments.
- ❖ The WHS clinics will be offering **both** the influenza vaccine and COVID-19 vaccine (Pfizer) to all eligible health care workers at AHS sites starting October 1.
- ❖ October 1, 2, 3, 6, and 7 WHS will work out of their clinic, 0800-1500 hours, 3rd Floor, 9334, Aberhart Bldg.
- ❖ WHS will join the site-wide campaign flu immunizers in Bernard Snell Hall on OCT 8th and will continue to offer both vaccines if COVID-19 vaccine eligible*** [whs-flu-walk-in-clinic.pdf](#)
- ❖ Healthcare eligibility for covid vaccine is outlined on [GoA website](#).
- ❖ Covid Vaccine is free of charge for those eligible at WHS or Public Health clinics (while supplies last)
- ❖ Eligible healthcare workers are encouraged to get their COVID-19 immunization at their earliest opportunity.
- ❖ The influenza vaccine and COVID-19 vaccine are given separately. You may choose to get both immunizations at the same time or at 2 different times.
