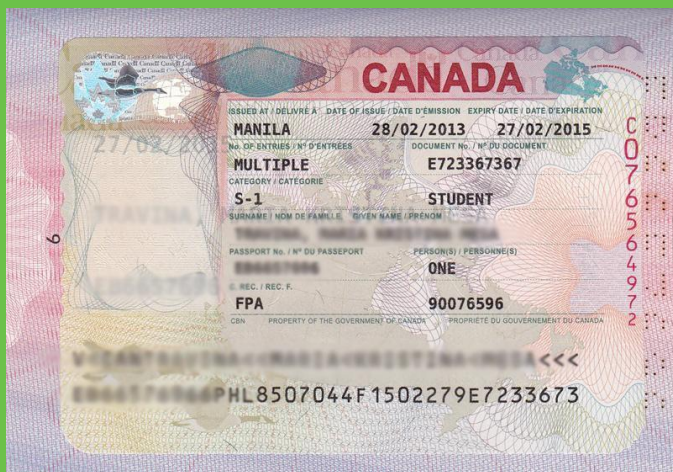

Visa

Your visa allows you to enter Canada.
Students who don't need a visa will need
an eTA for entry

Study Permit

Your study permit allows you to study
in Canada. You can remain in Canada
and study without a visa as long as
your SP is valid.

Work During Program of Studies

While studying *FULL TIME with a valid SP:*

- you have the option to work on **Campus** (unlimited number of hours)
- and **off campus** (up to 24 hours/week). Full time during **regularly scheduled breaks (spring/summer break*)**

Work After Program Completion

Post Grad Work Permits (PGWP) can be obtained after you have completed your program and receive a completion letter from your Faculty and your official transcript

Requirements include:

- Maintaining full time registration status during ALL academic terms (with the exception of your last term)
- PGWP is an open work permit

Health Insurance

Students Under 18

- You do not qualify for AHCIP!
- Apply for the **University of Alberta Health Insurance Plan (UAHIP)**.

Students Over 18

You may be eligible for **Alberta Health Care Insurance Plan (AHCIP)** if your study permit has been issued for **12** months or more,

Social Insurance Number (SIN)

Get your Social Insurance Number (SIN)

A SIN is a confidential nine-digit number needed to work in Canada or access government services. No registration is required.

Centre

To get a SIN you need:

- ☐ A valid study permit clearly indicating your authorization to work
- ☐ Passport
- ☐ Residential proof
