MEng Course Selection Rules

- Of your 8 (500, 600, 700 level) graduate courses, 4 courses MUST be within your specialization (i.e., Energy Systems, Control Systems)
- You MUST also take INT D 710 (Ethics Requirement) and ECE 910 (Capstone Project). INT D 710 should be completed in the first or second term of your first year. ECE 910 is generally completed in the final term of your program. INT D 710 and ECE 910 do not count toward your 8 course requirement
- If you start your program in September, you will be automatically enrolled in INT D 710 in your first term. If you start your program in January, you are responsible for registering in INT D 710
- Your course selection also MAY include up to two ENG M (Engineering Management) courses
- Your course selection MAY include up to two technical courses from other departments within the Faculty of Engineering and/or the Faculty of Science
- You MAY NOT take 400 level or Reading courses as part of your 8 course requirement
- You are allowed to take ONE extra, 9th course during your MEng program (this course can be an undergraduate or graduate course from any faculty/department, but requires special department approval and consultation prior to registration)
- Please consult the MEng Graduate Program Advisor should you have any questions or concerns
