Note: GSMS is not available for Postdoctoral Fellows; please refer to the [Postdoctoral Fellow Funding](#) section on the GPS website for available opportunities.

GSMS Access for Students

[Login to GSMS](#) with your Campus Computing ID (CCID) and password to access the Awards Portal.

1. In the *Username* field, enter your CCID only (do not include the “@ualberta.ca” suffix).

Note:

- Students on approved leaves of absence may not be able to access GSMS for the duration of their leave. Their GSMS access is automatically reinstated at the end of the leave.
- Students who have graduated will lose access to GSMS when they no longer have an active student relationship with the University of Alberta (about 5 months after the end date of their final term).
- It is recommended that you access the GSMS Awards portal from a desktop as the GSMS portal is not fully mobile compatible. On small screens/mobile devices, the tabs at the top of the Portal page may not be displayed (tabs include: *Admissions, Awards, Applicant Messages, Logout*; see figure below). Please default to desktop use.
