

RSJP Scholarship Statement of Purpose

The Prince Takamado Japan Centre is pleased to offer up to three (3) Prince Takamado Japan Canada Memorial Fund Summer Travel Awards valued at \$850.00 CAD each for participation in the Ritsumeikan Summer Japanese Program (RSJP).

To be considered for this award, applicants must submit a statement of purpose in English explaining why they wish to take part in the RSJP. The statement must be typed, in 12-point Times New Roman font, and be a maximum of 500 words.

Recipients of the Prince Takamado Japan Canada Memorial Fund Summer Travel Award are required to provide the Prince Takamado Japan Centre with a final report within two weeks of completion of the RSJP.

The final report must address the recipient's experience in Japan and reflect upon how their participation in the program positions them for their future growth, success, career path, and/or further pursuit of studies.

The report must be typed, in 12-point Times New Roman font, in English, be between 500 – 1,000 words and submitted to the Program Coordinator (ptjcprog@ualberta.ca).

If a recipient is unable to submit their report by the required deadline, they are to make alternative arrangements with the Program Coordinator (ptjcprog@ualberta.ca) as soon as possible.
