

French Placement Test Chart

Please note:

- Students with French 30 will NOT receive credits below FREN 211.
- French 30 is not required to place in FREN 211 or above.
- Students with some immersion and/or with IB French should talk to the coordinator to confirm placement.
- Native speakers or French immersion students (k-12) typically go directly into our French content classes (FREN 254 or FREN 300+)
- Students who place above FREN 297, or who have completed FREN 297, are eligible to take FREN 254 Introduction to Translation Theory and Practice: French-English-French, as FREN 297 is the prerequisite.
