Help your student get a sense of who you are not just as a preceptor, but also as a person!

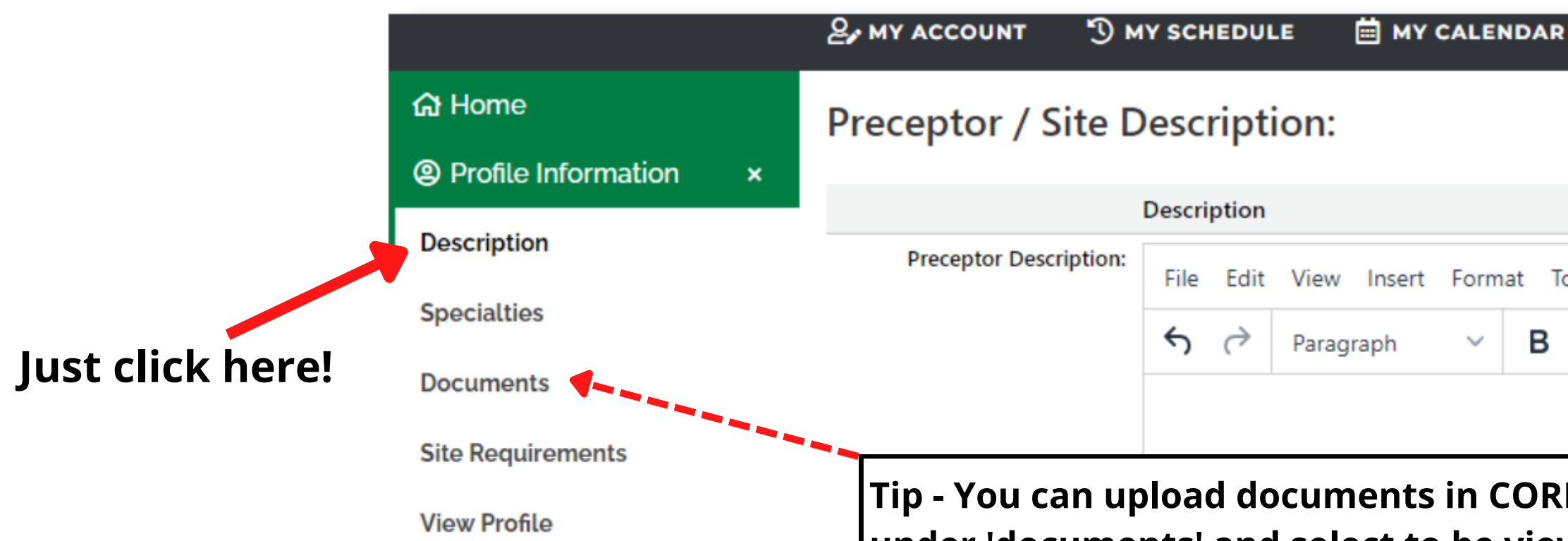
Things to potentially add include:
