REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Citizenship and Residency

All applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada. Proof of Canadian citizenship or permanent resident status must be valid (non-expired) as of **November 1**.

Uploaded documents must include both front and back sides (excluding passports).

Dental Marks/Transcripts and Internship Certificate

Transcripts must be provided for **all** post-secondary work ever completed.

Dental transcripts (or mark sheets) must detail **all courses taken** and grades received, including failed and repeated courses, within each term or year. Summaries are NOT accepted.

An internship certificate must be provided for applicants who have completed a rotating/compulsory internship.

Dental Degree

A copy of your dental degree will be required if the provided transcript does not indicate that the degree was conferred/awarded/granted.

License to Practice Dentistry

Applicants who are or have been licensed to practice dentistry in any jurisdiction must upload proof of licensure from all current and previous licensing bodies they have been affiliated with.

Certificate of Good Standing

Applicants who are or have been licensed to practice dentistry in any jurisdiction must upload letters of good standing (in English) from all current and previous licensing bodies they have been affiliated with.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Advanced Dental Admission Test (ADAT)

The ADAT is only offered between **March 1 to August 31** of each year.

Results must be sent **directly** from the ADA to the University of Alberta through ADEA Pass.

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English Proficiency Requirements

English is the primary language of instruction at the University of Alberta. All applicants must demonstrate proficiency in both written and spoken English.

More information on how to meet the English Language Proficiency and Spoken English Proficiency Requirements can be found at uab.ca/languageregs. Applicants may be exempt from these requirements if they have studied at qualifying institutions listed [here](#).

English test results must be no older than 2 years as of **November 1**.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS CHECKLIST

All documents must be received by **November 1**.

Applications will only be processed once all required documents and both application fees have been received.

Documents that are not in English must be accompanied by an English translation.

Applicants are responsible for uploading all documents to UAlberta Launchpad.
