DID YOU KNOW THAT...?

Our main chapel altar was designed by a 26-year-old graduate of the U of A's fine arts program? George Dexter of Calgary received an award for his design from the U.S. based National Liturgical Conference in 1968. Materials for the altar totaled around \$200, in 1968, which due to inflation would be around \$1700 today. The boys of St. Mary's School in Edmonton built the altar from Dexter's design. Dexter also designed the Blessed Sacrament altar and the processional cross.
