SAFE ENVIRONMENTS TRAINING

The Archdiocese of Edmonton has for a long time educated volunteers in the measures that keep our churches and programs safe for children and vulnerable adults. They have recently switched from Called to Protect to Safe Environments Training:

To send someone a link to the training program, volunteers need to fill out a volunteer information form and a covenant of care form (available from Fr. Jim) that includes their email information. They can then be set up in the database, and will get an invitation to take the training on the Praesidium Academy Safe Environments website. As soon as they finish the training the database will be updated from the Praesidium Academy. The email on the volunteer form will be used for the training invitation.

This process is much less burdensome than Called to Protect was, but its intent is the same: to empower volunteers with the knowledge they need to keep children and vulnerable adults safe. Whether you volunteer regularly or not, I hope you will consider receiving training.

RCIA FOR 2025/26

If you are interested in learning more about the process of becoming Catholic, contact Fr. Warren at wrschmid@ualberta.ca to get more information, and to be included in future updates. The process begins in the Autumn, and becomes more formal at the end of November. If all goes well, reception into the Church would happen at Easter, in April 2026. This process is also open to Catholics who still need to be confirmed.
