A GOODBYE NOTE FROM ZINIA

When I first came to St. Joseph's College Chapel (ca 2013), I was in the throes of doctoral work. I remember the student Mass back then was at 9:00 p.m. and there would be this long ant-like line of students making their way from the Cameron Library to St. Joe's every Sunday. After the doctorate, I felt so much at home here that I decided to stay.

Over the years, I've had the pleasure of serving the College and worshipping community in different capacities: teaching the first Introduction to the Roads to Happiness course, serving on the Board of Governors, being a lector and eucharistic minister, and supporting us during COVID through the Virtual Mass PowerPoint Host Team Ministry. I'm grateful for this place and this people: the priests who have served and nourished us by their preaching, the truly beautiful music ministry, our generous hearted hosts at the Christmas and Easter réveillon and the many vibrant faith-based conversations.

I will truly miss the beauty of soul that is St. Joseph's College. Know that I will hold this community in my heart and prayer as I relocate for the foreseeable future back to the UK to be closer to family.

I have come full circle... I came out to Canada to serve the Missionary Diocese of Prince George in pastoral leadership, moving to the Nelson Diocese to continue to provide pastoral and liturgical leadership, and then to the Edmonton archdiocese, endorsed for ministry as a spiritual care practitioner and subsequently as provincial Practice Director for health care chaplains across AHS. I now return to the British Church to serve as a contemplative practical theologian in my new call at the Margaret Beaufort Institute, a Roman Catholic affiliate of Cambridge University, in the role of Director of Pastoral and Spiritual Practice. It is with a deep sense of peace and gratitude that I say "yes" to this call.

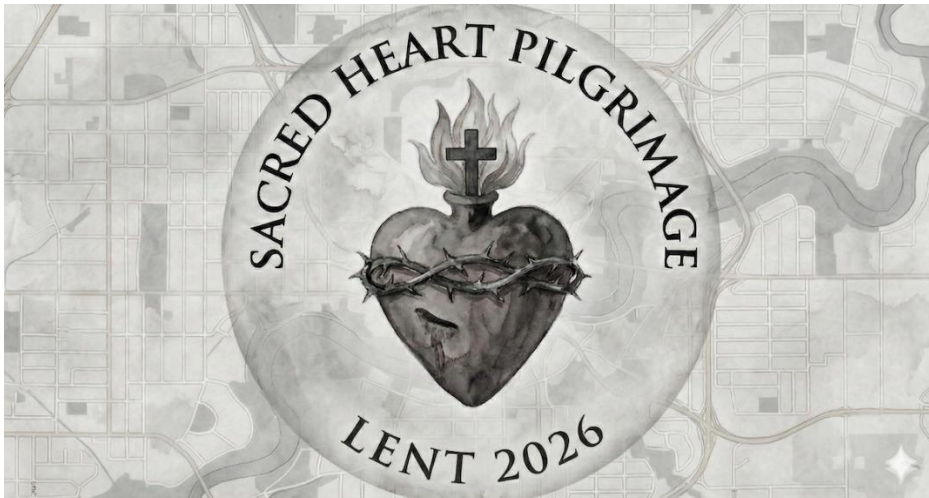
