DR. KEN MUNRO

A friend of the College passed away recently. Dr. Kenneth Munro left this life on Jan 24, 2026; the service was at First Presbyterian Church on Jan 31.

Ken Munro was a professor of history at the U of A since 1974. He served as Academic Dean here at St. Joseph's College for three years beginning in 2007. Although his tenure as Academic Dean ended, his friendship with the College endured. In Dr. Munro's history of St. Joseph's College, spanning almost 600 pages, you can see his affection for the College. SJC remembers Dr. Munro with gratitude.
