LENTEN ACTIVITIES

Lent is a 40-day period of reflection, repentance, and renewal leading up to Easter. Many Christians observe Lent through the practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. For example:

Prayer

- Spend time each day in prayer. Perhaps a few minutes in the morning or evening, or a longer time for deeper reflection.
- Pray the Stations of the Cross on Fridays (see below).
- Attend events advertised on <https://caedm.ca/events/>

Fasting

- Give up distractions (social media, Netflix, unnecessary spending).
- Abstain from meat on Fridays or simplify your meals.
- Fast from complaints, gossip, or negative self-talk.

Almsgiving

- Donate time, talent or resources to those in need.
- Support campus and local charities or food drives.
- Practice acts of kindness daily.
