Good Friday, April 3, 2026, 10 am.

This ecumenical prayer event marks the suffering and death of Jesus. It is a time to reflect on how gospel values apply to individual and public life today. This year's theme is based on Matthew 25:40 “Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.”

People of all faith traditions are welcome. The 1.5-kilometre walk is reasonable for most ages and ability levels. Free street parking is available near the start location at Sacred Heart Church. A light lunch (soup, bannock, coffee and tea) will be provided at Sacred Heart Church after the final station. Donations of non-perishable food items for local food banks are also welcome and can be dropped off at the start of the walk.
