PARKING LOT REGISTRATION NOW REQUIRED

The last few weeks we have been asking you to register your license plate to use the parking lot. We have a dedicated tablet for this purpose. This was for practice: the lot was still on leave alone. Now, however, if your vehicle is not registered, it will likely be ticketed. Some important facts:

- 1. You need to register your vehicle every time.** We don't want people to register once, and then have free gym parking the rest of the year.
- 2. The parking situation will take time to improve.** People who are ticketed likely will not come back, but other people might see the spaces and think, "Hey, free parking!" and so will fill up the spot.
- 3. U of A parking costs money.** If our parking lot is full, you must pay to use any other parking lot. They don't know who you are, and even if they did they wouldn't give you special treatment over anyone else.
- 4. Tickets must be disputed promptly.** If you get a ticket, send a picture of it as soon as possible to Fr. Jim, and the reason why you shouldn't have to pay it. There is a limited window in which these tickets can be appealed.
- 5. Parking tickets are not from SJC.** Part of our agreement with the U of A is that they monitor our lot and take care of the grounds, and in exchange they keep the money from parking tickets.

Oh, and special arrangements have been made for our musicians, who typically arrive very early for mass. They are automatically on the list. Now you have an incentive to volunteer for the choir!
