One topic that I (Fr. Jim) rarely see addressed in the debate about MAiD is how health-care professionals rarely wish to end lives; rather, they wish to heal and save them. There is a public interest, I think, in ensuring that this state of affairs continues. And just as no one would wish to end the life of a loved one, neither should a health-care worker be required to act contrary to their instinct to heal rather than to harm. This is not the same as conscience rights; courts are often suspicious that "conscience rights" could be used as cover for enabling bigotry and discrimination. The public interest in ensuring that health care professionals are devoted to healing is thus, I think, a more solid basis for opposing MAiD.
