CONFIRMATION CLASS

If you have a young person (no younger than grade 6) who wishes to be confirmed this coming spring/summer, please plan to be present at SJC on the following Sundays from 10:45 am until noon: Oct 19, Nov 2, Nov 23, Jan 11, Jan 25, Feb 8, Mar 1, and Mar 22. These are the dates and times the confirmation class will meet. The meetings will be led by our own Dr. Matt Hoven, and a parent volunteer will be needed at each session.

On two Thursday afternoons, the group will go to volunteer at a Catholic charity, visit a monastery/church, etc.: Nov 20 or 27, and Feb 19 or 26 (TBD). These details are still being finalized.

Classes will take place in the boardroom at St. Joseph's College. Each classroom session will involve stories of witnesses to faith (saints and everyday Catholics), connections to theology (creed, liturgy, moral life, prayer), time for reflection and discussion, games, short videos/readings, and a little bit of homework for the "off" week to be done with family (e.g., watch an animation of a gospel story and discuss it).

This is the first time we have had confirmation classes at SJC since before Fr. Jim became Chaplain in 2018. Please be patient as we figure out some of the pesky details: like what paperwork is needed. Please email Fr. Jim at jim.stenberg@ualberta.ca to express your interest in taking part.
