## TOGETHER WE SERVE FALL APPEAL

This year marks the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of "Together We Serve," where the parishes of the Archdiocese of Edmonton together raise funds for a variety of beneficiaries... including St. Joseph's College.

This weekend begins the Fall Appeal; in past years up to half the goal is raised between September and December; as of Sept 13, the campaign has 39% of its target yet to raise, well on track to exceeding the fundraising goal of \$1,536,510.

The beneficiaries of Together We Serve are divided between the categories of Worship, Witness and Service. St. Joseph's College is in the "Witness" section, along with Newman Theological College and the Evangelization of Nations (which involves missionary work).

I am grateful for the ways that the Archdiocese supports us here at St. Joseph's College, and I hope that we may be the shining example of witness that the Church calls us to be.
